Winter Surcharge  
USA to St. Petersburg, Russia**

Dear valued customers,

Effective **December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2009**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement a **Winter Surcharge for all exports from or via all US ports (USEC, USWC, and USGC) to St. Petersburg, Russia**. The amount of the surcharge will be:

<b>USD \$75.00</b>	<b>20' Container (all types)</b>
<b>USD \$150.00</b>	<b>40' Container (all types)</b>

This charge will apply on all dry or refrigerated cargo received and moving under a CMA CGM (America) LLC bill of lading, as of December 1, 2009, and is valid through March 31, 2010.
