Equipment Imbalance Surcharge (EIS)
Transpacific Westbound Trade from Canada**

Dear valued customers,

Effective **December 1st, 2009**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement an Equipment Imbalance Surcharge (EIS) on all cargo sailing from Vancouver to all destinations on our COLUMBUS and FUJI services. The new EIS will be as follows:

**USD \$150 40'ST container
USD \$250 40'HC container**

Implementation of the new EIS will cover equipment repositioning costs and imbalance surcharges for 40'ST and 40'HC equipment, and will help us to continue providing the high level of customer of service that is expected by our customers. Charges are effective on 40'ST and 40'HC equipment received on or after December 1, 2009.
