General Rate Increase (GRI)  
US East Coast and US Gulf Coast to the Indian Subcontinent, Afghanistan,  
Nepal, Sri Lanka, East Africa and Indian Ocean Islands**

Dear valued customers,

Effective **December 16, 2009**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement a General Rate Increase (GRI) for export cargo moving from or via the US East Coast and US Gulf Coast to all destinations in the Indian Subcontinent (India, Pakistan, Bangladesh), Afghanistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, East Africa and Indian Ocean Islands as follows:

**USD \$120 per 20' container (all types)  
USD \$150 per 40' container (all types)**

This increase will cover cargo moving under both tariff rates and service contracts, and will be applied on all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery on or after December 16<sup>th</sup>, 2009.
