Aden Gulf Surcharge (AGS) - Exports**

Dear valued customers,

To further address the known threat of piracy in the Gulf of Aden region, CMA CGM has taken increased measures of protection to insure safe passage of our vessels, crew, and ultimately the cargo on board.

In view of the above, CMA CGM has decided to update the **ADEN GULF SURCHARGE (AGS)** for the following trade lanes:

- **USEC and USGC to the Middle East, Indian Subcontinent and Indian Ocean islands**
- **USWC to the Red Sea, Mediterranean and North Europe destinations**

The AGS amounts will be **effective December 23rd, 2009**, as follows:

USD \$41 per 20' Container (all types)
USD \$82 per 40' Container (all types)
USD \$82 per 45' Container (all types)

Please note the updated surcharge will be applied on all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery on or after of December 23, 2009.
