Effective **January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will increase the Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) on all shipments from the U.S. ports of New York, Norfolk, Savannah, Boston, and Houston to Latin America (East & West Coast South America), Central America, and the Caribbean.
