Customer Advisory #100 – 2009
U.S. Export Roll Fee Changes
Effective September 12, 2009

Dear valued customers,

Effective **September 12, 2009**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will modify our current roll fees for all export shipments that are rolled to a different vessel **after** containers have already been delivered to the marine terminal. Roll fees are as follows:

- **USD \$200** – Incurred on **each** container sailing from all U.S. Ports **except Miami**.
- **USD \$90** – Incurred on **each** container sailing from POL Miami.

The above mentioned roll fees will be incurred **each** time a booking is rolled after it has already been delivered to the marine terminal. All **roll fees plus any additional charges incurred** to implement the requested rolls, such as shifting & re-handling fees, will be applied to the shipper's bill of lading. Any port demurrage will be separately invoiced. Rolls made for the convenience of CMA CGM will not be subject to roll fees.

****Re-handling fees apply when changes are made to a booking (i.e. change of POD) which may not require a vessel change. In the event of such changes, re-handling fees will be assessed in addition to the above charges as they apply.**
