### PEX 3 Change in Service

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to the continued strong demand of exports from the Port of Houston to Asia, CMA CGM will revise the rotation of our existing PEX 3 service on the return voyage to Asia.

This service will now call the USA port Houston, TX last and will return to Asia via the Panama Canal. Below we outline the anticipated transit times:

#### From Houston to direct ports of call:

Shanghai:	29 Days
Xiamen:	31 Days
Chiwan:	32 Days
Hong Kong:	33 Days

This will be **effective from the CMA CGM Orca PG438W ETD Houston September 11.**

This vessel will begin receiving export cargo on September 3 and the cargo cut off will be September 8. The original ETD of this vessel was scheduled for August 27. This new rotation will substantially improve the transit times to our scope of Asian destinations.
