Dear valued customers,

Effective **October 1, 2009**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will apply the following tariff Bunker Surcharge (BSC) on import shipments from Indian Subcontinent (India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh) and East Africa ports (Kenya, Tanzania, Mozambique, Mauritius, Madagascar, and Mayotte) to all points served by USEC and USG ports.
