### **Bunker Adjustment Factor Australia, New Zealand & French Polynesia to US East Coast and Gulf Coast**

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to changing market conditions, please be advised that an adjustment to the Bunker Adjustment Factor (BAF) for all import cargo loaded from Australia, New Zealand, and the French Polynesian islands to the United States East Coast and Gulf Coast, will be applied, as follows:

USD \$590	20' Container (all types)
USD \$1180	40' Container (all types)

This adjustment applies to all imports received on or after February 1, 2009 from Australia, New Zealand, and French Polynesia to all U.S. East Coast and Gulf Coast ports.
