General Rate Increase U.S. East Coast to Australia and New Zealand

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement a General Rate Increase (GR) on all exports from the U.S. East Coast to Australia and New Zealand.

This increase will apply on all dry and refrigerated cargo received and moving under a CMA CGM (America) LLC bill of lading, effective March 1, 2009, as follows:

USD \$200	20' Container (all types)
USD \$400	40' Container (all types)

This service is one of the longest trading routes in the world, however, its overall market size remains relatively small. This combination magnifies even minor increases in costs, and makes it one of the most expensive trade lanes to service.
