**Customer Advisory #138 – 2009
General Rate Increase (GRI)
All U.S. Ports to Asia**

Dear valued customers,

Effective **November 16, 2009**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will institute a GRI for export cargo moving from or via all US ports to all destinations in Asia which include but are not limited to China, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, Taiwan, Philippines, Cambodia, Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia, Vietnam and Indonesia. The rates will be as follows:

US East Coast Ports and US West Coast Ports:

All Water Port to Port:

USD \$150 20' container (all Types excluding Reefer containers)

USD \$200 40' container (all Types excluding Reefer containers)

USD \$190 20' Refrigerated container

USD \$250 40' Refrigerated container

IPI origins via USEC and USWC Ports:

USD \$150 20' container (all Types excluding Reefer containers)

USD \$200 40' container (all Types excluding Reefer containers)

USD \$190 20' Refrigerated container

USD \$250 40' Refrigerated container

US Gulf Coast Ports:

All Water Port to Port and IPI origins via USGC:

USD \$150 20' container (all Types excluding Reefer containers)

USD \$200 40' container (all Types excluding Reefer containers)

USD \$190 20' Refrigerated container

USD \$250 40' Refrigerated container

This increase will cover both cargo moving under tariff rates and service contracts and will be applied on all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of November 16, 2009.
