General Rate Increase (GRI)  
Ex. Houston to Asia Including MLB to West Coast**

Dear valued customers,

Effective **December 18<sup>th</sup>, 2009**, CMA CGM (America), LLC will implement a **General Rate Increase (GRI) for exports from Houston to Asia via our all water service, and also via Mini Land Bridge to the West coast**. This GRI comes as a result of the continued strength of the export market ex Houston to Asia as well as the reduced capacity. The rates listed below will apply to all destinations under the scope of **tariff 044** (including but not limited to: China, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, Taiwan, Philippines, Cambodia, Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia and Burma).

**USD \$150/20' Container (all types)  
USD \$200/40' Container (all types)**

The GRI will be applied to all NON EXEMPT cargo that is received and moving under a CMA CGM bill of lading, on or after December 18, 2009.

**\*\*This increase does not apply to exempt commodities.**
