Modified Amerigo Service

Dear Valued Customer,

CMA CGM (America) LLC is pleased to announce some modifications to the Amerigo service with the launch a new vessel sharing agreement with Maersk Line in March 2009. Under the agreement, CMA CGM will continue to provide weekly connections on the Amerigo service between Europe and the U.S. East Coast.

The last vessel under the current rotation will be the KOMODO GX521 Westbound and GX 522 Eastbound loading in the Mediterranean between March 5th (Malta) and March 12th (Lisbon).

The new service will operate 5 vessels, each with 3500 TEUs. CMA CGM will provide one vessel and Maersk Line will provide 4 vessels. The weekly service will have a 35 day rotation, as follows:

**Algeciras / Malta / Gioia Tauro / Livorno / Genoa / FOS / Algeciras
New York / Norfolk / Savannah / Miami / Algeciras**

Spanish ports will be covered weekly by a feeder via Algeciras and we will continue to be very active in this market. Portugal will also be served weekly by feeder via Algeciras.

This new service will offer increased reliability and faster transit times that will be unrivaled in the market.
