Indian Sub Continent & East Africa to USEC & USGC
Effective January, 2010

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **January 1st, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will apply the following Bunker Surcharge (BSC) on all cargo imported from Indian Subcontinent Ports and Points (India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, and Bangladesh), and East Africa Ports and Points (Kenya, Tanzania, Mozambique, Madagascar, and Mayotte) to the East Coast and Gulf Coast of the United States.

Imports from ISC and East Africa to USEC & USGC (Tariff 029)

USD \$334.00 / 20' container (all types)

USD \$418.00 / 40' container (all types)

USD \$470.00 / 40'HC container (all types)

USD \$529.00 / 45' container (all types)

The new BSC will be applied on all equipment received on or after January 1, 2010.
