### Emergency Bunker Adjustment Factor USA to Indian Subcontinent

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that due to changing fuels prices, CMA CGM (America) LLC will increase the Emergency Bunker Adjustment Factor (EBAF), effective March 5, 2009, for all export shipments from U.S. ports (USEC, USWC, and USGC) to the Indian Subcontinent, as follows:

|              |                           |
|--------------|---------------------------|
| USD \$314.00 | 20' Container (all types) |
| USD \$628.00 | 40' Container (all types) |

*Includes all special equipment and shipper-owned tanks.*

Exceptions: Wastepaper & Metal Scrap Emergency Fuel Surcharges

Please note that the EBAF will be applied upon receipt of cargo at store door, rail ramp or port delivery, as noted on bookings.
