### **Emergency Fuel Surcharge Reduction U.S. East Coast to Caribbean, Central America, and East Coast South America**

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that effective February 6, 2009, CMA CGM (America) LLC will reduce the Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) in our governing tariff for export cargo moving from U.S. East Coast ports to all ports in the Caribbean, Central America, and Brazil, as follows:

#### **New York, Baltimore, Norfolk, Savannah**

USD \$75     20' Container (all types)

USD \$150    40' Container (all types)

The EFS will be applied upon receipt of cargo at store door, rail ramp or port delivery if received on or after February 6, 2009.

Please note: Weekly service is now offered via New York in conjunction with sailings on the Black Pearl and Oceania PAN (RTW) services.
