Emergency Fuel Adjustment Factor USA to Australia and New Zealand *Oceania PAN (RTW) Service*

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that effective March 15, 2009 the Emergency Fuel Adjustment Factor (EFAF) for export cargo moving from United States East Coast and Gulf ports (and intermodal points) to Australia and New Zealand on the Oceania PAN (RTW) service, will be decreased, as follows:

USD \$288	20' Container (all types)
USD \$576	40' Container (all types)
USD \$576	40' High Cube Container (all types)

The EFAF will be applied upon receipt of cargo at store door, rail ramp or port delivery if received on or after March 15, 2009.
