Palletized Cargo Rule Riyadh, Saudi Arabia Rail Ramp

Dear Valued Customer,

Saudi Railway Organization (SRO) has instructed that all cargo arriving at the Riyadh rail ramp after February 25, 2009, must be palletized in accordance with international maritime rules for safe carriage, handling, and customs inspection.

Failure to comply with this rule may result in the delayed inspection and clearance of your cargo. In addition, consignees will be fined SAR 1000 (USD \$267) per 20 foot container and SAR 1500 (USD \$400) per 40' container by SRO for non-compliance. These fines must be paid directly by the consignees to Saudi Railway Organization before containers will be released.
