Vehicle Import Restriction Tripoli, Libya

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that due to a recent decision made by the Libyan Ministry of Transportation, effective March 15, 2009, no cars, automobiles and/or any other type of vehicles will be allowed to be imported (from any origin) through the port of Tripoli, Libya.

Imports of such commodities will still be accepted through the ports of El Khoms, Misurata and Benghazi. The age restriction for vehicle imports (maximum of five years old) remains in effect.
