Bunker Adjustment Factor US West Coast to Australia, New Zealand & French Polynesia

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to changing market conditions, please be advised that an adjustment to the Bunker Adjustment Factor (BAF) for all export cargo loaded from the United States West Coast (i.e. Long Beach, Los Angeles, Oakland & Seattle) to Australia, New Zealand, and the French Polynesian islands, will be applied, as follows:

Dry and Special Equipment

USD \$400 20' Container

USD \$500 40' Container

This adjustment applies to all exports received on or after January 1, 2009 from all U.S. West Coast ports to Australia, New Zealand, and French Polynesia.
