Sax Service Termination Asia to/from U.S. East Coast

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to changing economic conditions, CMA CGM (America) LLC will be suspending service to/from U.S. East Coast ports and Asia on the Sax service.

The last sailing eastbound will be the CMA CGM CHATEAU D'IF UP191E, departing Ningbo, China on March 30, 2009. The last westbound sailing will be the CMA CGM CHATEAU D'IF UP192W departing Jacksonville, Florida on Tuesday, April 28, 2009.

All confirmed bookings for these sailings will be honored and routed accordingly. Cargo booked on subsequent vessels will be loaded on the Pex 1 service to New York and Savannah, or the Pex 3 service to Norfolk. No additional bookings will be accepted for the Sax service.
