## **Customer Advisory #39 - 2009**

### **General Rate Increase U.S. Gulf Coast to Asia**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective May 1, 2009, CMA CGM (America) LLC will be implementing a General Rate Increase (GRI) for exports from Houston, Texas and Mobile, Alabama to all destinations in Asia (including, but are not limited to; China, Hong Kong, Japan, Korea, Taiwan, Philippines, Cambodia, Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia, Vietnam, Indonesia, and Burma.)

This GRI also applies to all Mini Land Bridge (MLB) cargo bound for Asia moving from Houston to U.S. West Coast ports for export. The GRI will be applied to all dry and refrigerated cargo, received and moving under a CMA CGM (America) LLC bill of lading, effective May 1, 2009, as follows:

USD \$100 20' Container (all types)  
USD \$200 40' Container (all types)

This increase does not apply to exempt commodities.
