### **Amendment** **General Rate Increase** **Indian Subcontinent to United States**

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that effective **June 1, 2009**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement a General Rate Increase (GRI) for all imports to United States ports (USEC, USWC, and USGC) from the Indian Subcontinent & Middle East (India, Pakistan, UAE, Oman, Bahrain, Kuwait, Qatar, Egypt, Saudi Arabia), as follows:

USD \$400	20' Dry Van Container
USD \$500	40' Dry Van Container
USD \$565	40' High Cube Container
USD \$635	45' Dry Van Container

This increase will apply on all dry or refrigerated cargo, received and moving under a CMA CGM (America) LLC bill of lading effective **June 1, 2009**. Please note that all charges will be applied upon receipt of cargo at store door, rail ramp, or port delivery, as noted on bookings.
