### **Emergency Fuel Surcharge Revision USA to North Europe, Mediterranean, North Africa, Middle East Gulf and Red Sea**

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that due to the fluctuating price of oil, effective February 1, 2009, CMA CGM (America) LLC will decrease the Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) for all export cargo moving from U.S. origins to all ports in North Europe, Baltic, Scandinavia, UK, Ireland, East Mediterranean, West Mediterranean, Adriatic, Black Sea, North Africa, Red Sea and Persian Gulf, as follows:

USD \$52.00	20' Container (all types)
USD \$104.00	40' Container (all types)

Please note that the new EFS amount will be applied to all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of February 1, 2009.
