China Customs Advanced Manifest Regulation (CCAM)

Dear Valued Customer,

The official enforcement date of the new China Customs Advanced Manifest Regulation (CCAM) was January 1, 2009. Although no official grace period has been announced by China Customs, CMA CGM (America) LLC has been verbally advised that there will be a three to six month transition period without associated penalties.

CMA CGM began transmitting our China manifest, based on the new governmental regulations, as of January 1st. We will remain in compliance with these new rules, and as we continue to refine our process, we will provide you with the latest updates.

In order to comply with this regulation, all Shipping Instructions (SI) must be received by CMA CGM one working day prior to the advertised operational (port) cutoff for each vessel. Please visit the "[Schedules](#)" page on our Web site at www.cma-cgm.com/usa for our published documentation cutoff listed by vessel. Your Shipping Instructions must contain all of the information noted in [Customer Advisory #178](#).
