Emergency Fuel Adjustment Factor USA to West Coast South America *Andex Service*

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that effective January 16, 2009, the Emergency Fuel Adjustment Factor (EFAF) for export cargo moving from United States ports (and intermodal points) to the West Coast of South America on the Andex service, will be decreased, as follows:

USD \$100	20' Container (all types)
USD \$200	40' Container (all types)
USD \$200	40' High Cube Container (all types)

The EFAF will be applied upon receipt of cargo at store door, rail ramp or port delivery if received on or after January 16, 2009.
