Terminal Handling Charge (THC)
Pakistani Ports

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that due to the Federal Excise Duty recently imposed by the Government of Pakistan, effective **September 1, 2009**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will adjust the Terminal Handling Charge at Pakistani ports for all export and import cargo as follows:

PKR 7,550 per 20' Container (all types) for non-hazardous cargo
PKR 11,350 per 40' Container (all types) for non-hazardous cargo

PKR 12,000 per 20' Container (all types) for hazardous cargo
PKR 20,200 per 40' Container (all types) for hazardous cargo

PKR 10,750 per 20' Container (all types) for non-hazardous cargo on CFS basis
PKR 17,800 per 40' Container (all types) for non-hazardous cargo on CFS basis

PKR 15,500 per 20' Container (all types) for hazardous cargo on CFS basis
PKR 26,850 per 40' Container (all types) for hazardous cargo on CFS basis

Currency: Pakistani Rupee (PKR)

Please note that the new THC amounts will be applied on all shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of September 1, 2009.
