Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **August 12th, 2009**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will apply the following Peak Season Surcharge (PSS) to all contract and tariff rates on West Bound INDAMEX voyages for cargo originating from India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Oman, Kuwait, UAE Bahrain, Qatar, Jordan, Kenya, Tanzania for discharge in all US ports.

USD \$320	20' Standard Container
USD \$400	40' Standard Container
USD \$450	40" High Cube Container
USD \$510	45' Standard Container

As a reminder, it is critical during the peak season to accurately forecast your shipment volumes, and arrange bookings as early as possible. This will enable our vessel space planners and equipment managers to minimize peak season shortages of space or equipment and ensure that we are able to meet the needs of your business.
