General Rate Increase (GRI)
US East Coast & Gulf Coast to Indian Subcontinent
East Africa & Indian Ocean Islands

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **September 7, 2009**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will institute a GRI for export cargo moving from or via the US East Coast and US Gulf Coast to all destinations in the Indian Subcontinent scope (India, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Afghanistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, East Africa and Indian Ocean Islands), as follows:

USD \$240 20' container (all types)

USD \$300 40' container (all types)

This increase will cover both cargo moving under tariff rates and service contracts and will be applied on all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of September 7th 2009.
