Piracy Risk Surcharge – East Africa & Indian Ocean Islands
Effective August, 2010**

Dear valued customers,

Further to the most recent advisories regarding the threat of piracy off the coasts of Somalia as well as Kenya, CMA-CGM has taken all steps to ensure security of its vessels sailing through this area.

As the situation continue to worsen, CMA CGM is increasing the Piracy Risk Surcharge (PRS) as of August 1st, 2010 for all shipments ex USA and destined for East African and Indian Ocean islands destinations, as follows:

USD \$ 130 per 20' Container (all types)
USD \$ 260 per 40' Container (all types)

Please note the new PRS amounts will be applied on all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of August 1st, 2010.
