



**Customer Advisory #116 – 2010 –Amendment 2
Surcharge Update
Venezuelan Ports
Effective August 8, 2010**

Dear Valued Customer,

In view of the current situation and operational challenges in Venezuela, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement the following surcharges for Venezuelan ports:

- **Emergency Port Surcharge (EPS):** Applicable Puerto Cabello only, increase from US\$ 250/teu to US\$ 350/teu.
- **Equipment Surcharge:** Applicable to all Venezuelan ports; dry cargo US \$100/teu, and Reefer cargo US\$200/teu.
- **Demurrage and Detention conditions** will be modified for all import cargo in Venezuela: free time will be increased for dry cargo from 7 days to 14 days and reefer cargo from 4 to 10 days.
- **DTHC payment:** DTHC must remain prepaid.

These charges will apply to all cargo which are received and moving under a CMA CGM bill of lading on or after August 8th, 2010 in **the United States and Canada.**
