Port Congestion Surcharge (PCS)  
USA to Calcutta and Haldia  
Effective January 15, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that due to the ongoing worsening of the congestion situation at the port of Calcutta and Haldia, India, CMA CGM (America) LLC has to implement a Port Congestion Surcharge (PCS) for all shipments from the United States to these Indian ports effective January 15, 2011, as follows:

<b>Size</b>	<b>Type</b>	<b>Level (USD)</b>
<b>20'</b>	<b>(all types)</b>	<b>\$150.00</b>
<b>40'</b>	<b>(all types)</b>	<b>\$300.00</b>

Please note that the new surcharge will be applied on all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of January 15, 2011.
