Emergency Revenue Charge (ERC)  
Asia & ISC to U.S.  
Effective May, 2010**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will increase the Emergency Revenue Charge (ERC), which was originally implemented on January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2010 (CA #179), on all imports from North Asia, Southeast Asia, and the Indian Subcontinent, to the United States. The following charges are meant to help restore freight rates to a more sustainable level.

The ERC **will apply to all existing contracts** subject to CMA CGM tariffs covering shipments from North East Asia, South East Asia, or Indian Subcontinent to USA, **with expiration date beyond May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010**.

This ERC will **expire upon signature of the new Service Contract including the May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 GRI**; thus bridging the gap between conditions of existing contracts with validity over May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010, and new contracts effective May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010 – ensuring equal treatment between customers irrespectively of the contract signature date.
