USA to North Europe, Mediterranean, Middle East, & Red Sea  
Effective May, 2010**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will adjust the Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) for all export cargo moving from all U.S. origins, to all destinations in Europe, Baltic, Scandinavia, UK, Ireland, East Mediterranean, West Mediterranean, Adriatic, Black Sea, North Africa, Red Sea and Persian Gulf, as follows:

**EFS as of May 1<sup>st</sup>**

**USD \$152.00 20' Container (all types)**

**USD \$304.00 40' Container (all types)**

Please note that the new EFS amount will be applied on all export shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port as of May 1, 2010.

**Current EFS for the month of April**

**USD \$149.00 20' Container (all types)**

**USD \$298.00 40' Container (all types)**
