**Effective June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement the following Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) for all export cargo moving from all U.S. origins to all destinations in North Europe, Baltic, Scandinavia, UK, Ireland, East Mediterranean, West Mediterranean, Adriatic, Black Sea, North Africa, Red Sea, and Persian Gulf.
