Effective January 1, 2012**

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that due to increased costs at Nhava Sheva and Mundra ports, effective January 1, 2012, CMA CGM (America) LLC will be applying the below mentioned Destination Terminal Handling Charges for export cargo moving from all U.S. origins, East Coast, West Coast and Gulf, as follows:
