Detention Free Time and Rates Increase
Effective January 1, 2012**

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that effective **January 1, 2012**, will implement the below changes to the Detention free time and charges for Import and Export Shipments into and out of the U.S.

Import and Export Containers Only

Equipment	Free Days	Days 6-10	Each Calendar Thereafter
Dry/Standard	5 Working Days	\$ 90	\$ 135
Equipment	Free Days	Days 4-7	Each Calendar Thereafter
Specialized Refrigerated	3 Working Days	\$ 160	\$ 210

Import and Export Container & Chassis Provided by CMA

Equipment	Free Days	Days 6-10	Each Calendar Thereafter
Dry/Standard	5 Working Days	\$ 105	\$ 150
Equipment	Free Days	Days 4-7	Each Calendar Thereafter
Specialized Refrigerated	3 Working Days	\$ 175	\$ 225

Exceptions:

Import Refrigerated cargo discharging in the Port of Philadelphia will have day of interchange plus the next 3 working days free with a flat rate of \$160 per day, or \$175 per day when a container/chassis setup is provided by CMA CGM. Export Refrigerated cargo loading out of the Port of Oakland will have day of interchange plus the next three working days free with the above rates to apply.
