Effective April 24th, 2011

Dear Valued Customer,

Please be advised that **Effective April 24th, 2011**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will adjust the Emergency Fuel Surcharge (EFS) / Bunker Adjustment Factor for all cargo from U.S. and Canada to Caribbean, Central America, Mexico, West Coast South America and East Coast South America:

Size	Type	Level (USD)
20'	(all types)	\$500.00
40'	(all types)	\$1000.00
40'HC	(all types)	\$1000.00
45'	(all types)	\$1070.00

This charge will apply to all cargo received and moving under a CMA CGM bill of lading on all export shipments, all types of cargo, upon receipt at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of April 24th 2011.
