Cargo Cut Off Date Change for Exports from Seattle
Effective Immediately**

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to the implementation of the Advance Commercial Information (ACI) Program by the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA), CMA-CGM is required to transmit marine cargo data to CBSA 24 hours prior to loading cargo in Seattle.

In order to align our process and minimize various cut off dates, CMA-CGM will adjust the cut off dates for export cargo on our Columbus PNW service sailing out of Seattle.

Based on Pro Forma Vessel Schedule, documentation cut off and cargo cut off date will both be at close of business on Thursdays.

The new documentation and cargo cut off date will be effective immediately starting with the CMA CGM Parsifal voyage US348W, sailing from Seattle on April 3, 2011.
