Cargo Facility Charge (CFC) – New York
Effective June 1, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective **June 1, 2011**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement a **Cargo Facility Charge (CFC)** in the amount of **\$4.95 per TEU**. The charge will be applicable on all containers loading or discharging in **New York** port regardless of whether the final destination is the port, a container yard, store door (SDD), IPI, RIPI, IPI/SDD, or RIPI/SDD destination.

This CFC is being assessed by the Port to increase the operational efficiency of the movement of cargo in and out of the Port area as well as reduce truck congestion and idle times. The port will use the CFC for infrastructure improvement projects including expanding port roadway capacity, implementing additional cargo security measures for cargo and reducing emissions due to truck idling.
