Update on US Exports to Libya**

Dear Valued Customer,

We are all aware of the situation that has been ongoing in Libya for the past several months. During the past nine weeks, CMA CGM has managed to effect six port calls into Libya, and we remain open for bookings ex USA at this time.

However, due to the uncertain nature of the situation, we are unable to confirm transit times or delivery dates into the various ports in the country, nor are we currently accepting any hazardous cargo bookings or refrigerated cargo into any Libyan port.

Currently we have implemented a War Risk Surcharge on cargo to all Libyan ports, at the following amount:

**USD \$150 per 20' Container (all types)**  
**USD \$300 per 40' Container (all types)**
