New DTHC Amounts at India Ports
Effective July 1, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to increased operational costs in India, effective July 1, 2011, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement new **DTHC (Destination Terminal Handling Charge)** amounts for the ports of Nhava Sheva, Mundra, Haldia, Mangalore and Tuticorin for all export cargo originated in the U.S.A. The amounts shown below are shown in local currency (Indian Rupees) at the below levels:
