DTHC Update – Refrigerated Cargo
August, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to increased costs in various European Ports, effective **August 1st, 2011**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will be applying the below mentioned Destination Terminal Handling Charges for refrigerated cargo for the following countries.

Netherlands, Germany, United Kingdom, Portugal, and Estonia.

Below you will find the current DTHC along with the NEW applicable DTHC in local currency. The below charges can be found in tariffs 028,091.

Country/Port	OLD THC	New DTHC	Difference
Netherlands (Rotterdam)	€205	€240	+€35
Germany (Hamburg)	€280	€300	+€20
UK	£155	£165	+£10
Portugal	€165	€170	+€5
Estonia (Tallin)	€110	€120	+€10

It is important to note that power and monitoring charges are in addition to the amount listed above.

The DTHC amounts mentioned in this advisory will be applicable to all refrigerated cargo shipments leaving the United States upon receipt at store door, rail ramp, or port delivery on or after August 1st, 2011.
