Bunker Adjustment Factor
Far East to USA
Effective July 1, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective July 1, 2011 through September 30, 2011, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement the following **BAF** for all import cargo from Far East Origins to USA port, IPI and RIPI destinations.

(A) For destination: USWC, GROUP 4 and IPI

**USD 430 per 20' container
USD 538 per 40' container
USD 605 per 40' high-cube container
USD 681 per 45' high-cube container
USD 861 per 53' high-cube container**

(B) For destination: USEC and RIPI

**USD 847 per 20' container
USD 1059 per 40' container
USD 1191 per 40' high-cube container
USD 1341 per 45' high-cube container**

This charge will apply to ALL equipment types which are received and moving under a CMA CGM bill of lading on or after **July 1, 2011**.

During the course of the third quarter, we will continually monitor bunker levels in order to accurately capture the true costs of fuel as well as the impact of slow steaming. We will adjust accordingly as conditions warrant moving into the fourth quarter of the year.
