Hazardous Cargoes Documentation Administration Fee
Effective August 1, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective August 1, 2011 CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement a Hazardous Cargoes Documentation Administration Fee of \$250(USD) for cargo that is discharged at a U.S. port prior to Merchant's timely, complete and correct, written filing of Hazardous Declarations (49 C.F.R. or IMDG Code).

This Administrative fee will be assessed against each declaration (vice Bill of Lading) that requires supplement, correction, or resubmission before continued movement of cargoes within the United States.

All additional charges and costs arising from delay between discharge and the supplement, correction, or resubmission (i.e., per diem charges) shall be charged to the Merchant responsible for filing the Hazardous Declaration.
