In-bond Paperwork for Export Shipments**

Dear Valued Customer,

Our Export Documentation Team has been receiving an increased amount of in-bond audits and penalties from Customs and Border Protection for incomplete (non-closed) Immediate Exportation "IE" and Transportation and Exportation "T&E", that show CMA CGM's bond number nominated as the export carrier.

If you are using CMA CGM's in bond number on your CBP form 7512, the CBP form 7512 must be presented to us for signature prior to cargo exporting the USA. A signed copy by CBP must be returned to CMA CGM (America) LLC in order to be included with the filing of the manifest.

All costs and penalties generated due to delayed receipt of these forms will be for the shipper's account.
