October 1, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Due to increased costs in Estonia, effective **October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011**, CMA CGM (America) LLC will be applying the below mentioned Destination Terminal Handling Charges for refrigerated cargo, in local currency. The below charges can be found in tariff 091

<b>Country/Port</b>	<b>OLD DTHC</b>	<b>New DTHC</b>	<b>Difference</b>
<b>Estonia (Tallin)</b>	€120	€230	+€110

It is important to note that power and monitoring charges are in addition to the above amounts.

The DTHC amounts mentioned in this advisory will be applicable to all refrigerated cargo shipments leaving the United States upon receipt at store door, rail ramp, or port delivery on or after **October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011**.
