US Import / Export Demurrage Change
September 19, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Effective September 19, 2011, CMA CGM (America) LLC will implement a change to the Demurrage free time calculation. When any terminal, port and/or rail ramp is open for receiving/delivery on Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, free time will count as a regular working day.

The free time remains the same as shown in the below table:
