Congestion Surcharge  
Tunis, Tunisia  
Effective September, 2011**

Dear Valued Customer,

Over the last few weeks, the congestion situation at the Port of Tunis, Tunisia is getting further deteriorated. Ships are waiting for over two weeks to be allowed at the terminal as operations are carried out very slowly.

There are very little signs of immediate improvement, and in order to recover some of the additional costs occurring due to this congestion situation, CMA CGM America is compelled to implement a **PORT CONGESTION SURCHARGE of USD 100 per TEU** for all containers discharging at the port of Tunis, Tunisia.

Please note that the new surcharge will be applied on all shipments upon receipt of cargo (all types of commodities) at store door, rail ramp or port delivery as of September 22, 2011.
