**Customer Advisory #89 – 2011  
USEC Hurricane Irene Vessel Delays**

Dear Valued Customer,

With the inclement weather approaching the USEC, please see the below information regarding the import / export voyages for this weekend.

Camellia / Amerigo GX776E – For safety of vessel & crew, the vessel has ceased its passage to NY & will set adrift in the Atlantic until Hurricane passes. New ETA per Captain Tuesday 30th at 0600hr.

CC Figaro / Columbus US458N – Vessel completed operations in Norfolk at 0030 this morning and sailed 0100hrs EAST around the Hurricane – New ETA Sunday 28th 1300hrs start into Savannah (1 day delay).

CMA CGM Puget / Indamex IN780E – Vessel has slowed its passage to NY to allow the hurricane to pass – Depending on port conditions & labor availability – New ETA Sunday 28th 1900 or Monday 29th 0800hrs

CMA CGM Amber / Pex3 PG644W – Vessel has sailed to sea to avoid hurricane in Charleston, awaiting new update from Capt with ETA into CHS (Delayed into CHS & NY)

Liberty2 / SL Meteor LY090W – Vessel expected NY ETA 8/27 at 1500hrs & begin work on arrival, this is very tentative due to possibility of USCG closing the port by 1900hrs (tentative awaiting update)

APL Egypt / Liberty LB587E (discharge) – Vessel commenced operations in NY @ 0800 this morning with ETD of 2300 & set sailing to Europe (no impact expected)

APL Sardonyx / Liberty LB606W (import) – Per APL, vessel still expected to commence operations 0700 Saturday 8/27 in NY with ETD 2200hrs / completion of operations remains tentative due to possible port closure USCG (Delays expected)

CMA CGM Matisse / PAD RP288N – Vessel is scheduled for AM start in PHL on Monday 29th after hurricane passes (No impact expected)

Pearl River / Black Pearl BY201S – Vessel commenced operations @ 0700 in NY with ETD 1700hrs & will set sail to Halifax (no impact expected).
